



British Columbia Rhythmic Sportive Gymnastics Federation Criteria for Carding with PacificSport/Canadian Sport Centre Pacific

PacificSport/Canadian Sport Centre Pacific will offer BCRSGF **seven** spots for athlete carding at a Provincial Level (for the 08-09 season).

Criteria and Priority Rankings

1. Athletes who have Senior Sport Canada cards (Canadian Elite/Podium)*
2. Athletes who have Developmental Sport Canada cards (Canadian Elite)*
3. Athletes who are on the Senior National Team but who are not carded by Sport Canada (BC Elite)*
4. Athletes who are members of the Senior National Group but who are not carded by Sport Canada (BC Elite)*
5. Athletes who are on the Junior National Team but who are not carded by Sport Canada (BC Development)
6. Athletes who are members of the Junior National Group but who are not carded by Sport Canada (BC Development)*
7. The top three ranked Novices at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
8. Senior athletes ranking 11th – 15th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
9. Junior athletes ranking 11th – 15th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
10. Novice athletes ranking 4th – 8th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
11. Senior athletes ranking 16th – 20th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
12. Junior athletes ranking 16th – 20th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)
13. Novice athletes ranking 9th – 20th at the Canadian National Championships (BC Development)

*Are automatically given Canadian Elite cards (Podium, where applicable) and are NOT included in the seven spots allocated to BCRSGF

Notes:

1. Cards will be allocated until the spots have run out (eg. A Junior athlete ranking 13th will ONLY receive a card if there is space available)
2. Within each criteria, athletes with a higher ranking will have priority (eg. An Senior athlete ranking 12th would have a higher priority than the Senior athlete ranked 14th)
3. BCRSGF will notify the club and the athlete of her eligibility. It is the responsibility of the athlete to register/renew with PacificSport/Canadian Sport Centre Pacific
4. Based on capacity, some PacificSport/Canadian Sport Centre Pacific centres may be able to accept some more athletes beyond the guaranteed seven sports for BCRSGF. BCRSGF will submit a request to PacificSport/Canadian Sport Centre Pacific centres to determine if additional athletes (considered Talent Pool) can also access services with a BC Development card..
5. Talent Pool athletes will only be supported by BCRSGF if they are in good standing with the federation, are currently a National Stream athlete and currently have a National ranking (have attended nationals in the previous year).
